INFORMATION PROTECTION TIDBIT Safe Combination Changes

If you work around a safe or in an open storage location, I'll bet you wondered how often the combination gets changed. After all, this is the kind of information you have to commit to memory since it's unlawful to write it down and put it in your wallet/purse or store it on any unclassified media. Well it's fairly simple and with one exception, it's pretty much common sense. Of course you're going to change the combination when you first put the safe into use. After all, new safes come with a preset combo (50-25-50) and leaving the safe at the preset combo would be like not changing the locks on your house after you buy it (unless you want the previous owners to have access to your

home – I don't). You're also going to change the combo when you take it out of service. Why? If you don't and someone locks the safe, the next person won't be able to get into the safe without going through the expense of having it drilled and a new lock installed. That's why we change the combo a set it back to the default (50-25-50). We're also going to change the combination anytime some who knows the combo no longer requires or is eligible for access (this includes PCS, PCA, losing a clearance, etc.). Of course, if the combination is compromised, it will be immediately changed. And here's the interesting one; anytime you store NATO information in the safe there is a requirement to change the combination on an annual basis. There simple huh. If you need any help with these facts, please contact your unit security manager. If you need to have a safe drilled (let's hope this doesn't happen), call your security manager and then contact the 65 CE Locksmith at 535-3134.
