least a Favorable investigations or security clearance! So what can we do for these folks? Well, there is a process, and it requires unit commander approval. First, summer hire/volunteer access cannot exceed 180-days. If it does, the individual will have to be put in for a Federal background investigation. Second, the person will have to undergo Privacy Act and FOUO training. They are also required to take the same Information Assurance training you and I take every year. A local files check will be accomplished and the person will be limited to the least critical IT-III positions. It may sound involved, but it really isn't. Please contact your unit security manager for specific detailed step-by-step guidance on this process.

### TRICARE Suspicious Calls

Recently there has been a rash of calls to military personnel from individuals (NFI) who claimed to be with DoD and requested information under the guise of it being a

TRICARE national survey. If you receive a call that request personal information, do not disclose it. Ask the caller basic type questions to help ensure you determine if the call is legitimate i.e. a call back number, their name and employee number, the name of the company needing the information, and why they need your personal information. Remember your personal information is yours and you need to protect it.
