During October and November the young birds Cory Shearwater (Cagarro) leave the nests for the first time at night to fly on a journey of hundreds of miles. Air Force Climate Survey!

It is once again time for the Air Force Climate Survey! The 2010 Air Force Climate Survey launches Oct. 1, 2010. This survey has a huge impact on Airmen and their leadership, as evidenced by consistently high participation rates since 2001. Invitations will be sent by email, in large batches, in an attempt to avoid AF Portal overload and regulate flow to Randolph AFB servers. The email will contain an individualized personalized link to take the survey. **DO NOT FORWARD EMAIL INVITATIONS.** Respondents will receive an email invitation with an individual link to take the survey. Respondents can only access the survey through that link using their government CAC. The invitation is not to be forwarded nor shared with any other person. Respondents can log-out and login again at any point during the survey. Once a respondent has completed the survey, it will no longer be available for modifications.

The 2010 Air Force Climate Survey assesses factors that impact units and work centers. Through the Air Force Climate Survey, each respondent can provide direct feedback to his or her unit leadership. The survey questions are grouped into statistically reliable categories, or factors, that measure organizational climate concepts and provide leadership with a summary of those particular areas for their organization. In addition to a set of basic questions that show trends over time, new items were added to this year's survey that reflect current AF issues with open comment questions. The 2010 Air Force Climate Survey will be conducted 1 Oct - 28 Nov 2010.

INFORMATION PROTECTION TIDBIT

Information Protection Tidbit

Debriefings- Who, When, How & Why

Debriefings and classified information; we've all heard of them, but do you know when they are required. A lot of people don't and the goal of this little Tidbit is to help clarify this issue. First let's focus just on those with access to collateral classified information (no special access). Debriefings are required on anyone who has security clearance eligibility. If a US Civilian is Retiring, Separating, Retiring or PCSing, a debriefing needs to be accomplished. Why PCS? Unlike active duty military personnel, US Civilians can terminate employment enroute to the next duty assignment. Therefore, we want to make sure, that should they do that, they have already been debriefed. Now, as for active duty, they need to be debriefed for all the same reasons, except PCSing. Now, let's press forth to special access. The special access we deal a lot with here at Lajes is NATO. The only difference here is you will add Permanent Change of

Assignment to the reasons for debriefings. Also, military personnel, along with civilian personnel will be debriefed from NATO upon a PCS since access to NATO is driven by the position (and you're not taking that with you). It's that simple. If you have any questions regarding debriefings, please contact your unit security manager. They are full of all kinds of security information.

TRICARE Suspicious Calls

Recently there has been a rash of calls to military personnel from individuals (NFI) who claimed to be with DoD and requested information under the guise of it being a TRICARE national survey. If you receive a call that request personal information, do not disclose it. Ask the caller basic type questions to help ensure you determine if the call is legitimate i.e. a call back number, their name and employee number, the name of the company needing the information, and why they
