CORY SHEARWATER CAMPAIGN

It's time again for Cory Shearwater Rescue Campaign Oct 1 – Nov 15! Project objective: Reduce the mortality of young Cory Shearwater during their first flights after leaving the nests. During October and November the young birds Cory Shearwater (Cagarro) leave the nests for the first time at night to fly on a journey of hundreds of miles. Disoriented by artificial lights they fly inland instead of seaward. The species are protected by Portuguese and International Laws. Procedures are attached.
