AFI 91-207 USAFE Sup:

3.5.2.1. (Added) In cases where separation of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic is not feasible, military personnel in uniform must wear reflective accessories during periods of reduced visibility (hours of darkness, inclement weather, etc). Personnel in civilian attire are encouraged to wear light-colored clothing or reflective accessories. This requirement must be briefed during newcomers' orientation and addressed in the installation traffic code.

THE INDOOR GOLF HOLE CHALLENGE

The Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) is hosting the Lajes Indoor Golf Challenge in celebration of Engineer Week. The event is co-sponsored by FSS and will be held in the TORC Ballroom on Friday, 4 March. Basically, the event is split into two phases...

1. Lajes currently has no indoor mini-golf course, so participants must construct a hole. Holes can be no larger than 4x16 feet. They can have battery operated movements, sounds and lights, but cannot tap into the ballroom outlets. Water hazards can also be used as a feature, but the water must remain contained within the hole itself (cannot spill). Judging will be based on creativity, best use of materials, and level of challenge. Construction can start immediately, but official golf hole set-up

will be on Thursday, 3 March in preparation for the judging and playing of the holes on Friday, 4 March.

2. Once construction is complete, there will be an opportunity for team play. Teams consist of 4 players and the lowest team score on the indoor mini-golf course wins. This phase of the competition begins at 1300 at the TORC ballroom on 4 March.

Overall, the entire event is open to anyone who wants to build and/or play. There’s no cost to enter or to play once the course is complete. The mini-golf course will be available for public play throughout the weekend of 4-6 March...again there’s no entrance fee or cost. The only caveat is that funding for materials or to construct the hole must be private.
