### **COMPLIANCE WITH MAILBOX SIZE**

USAFE is scheduled to migrate to a AF-wide Network Operations Standard over the next couple months. This requires all USAFE bases to be within compliance with AF level directed email box size limits. All USAFE bases have been given a deadline to accomplish this task. Lajes is leading the way with a USAFE 8 March deadline.

To ensure we meet this USAFE-level suspense and minimize user impact, the 65th Communications Squadron has targeted March 8 to attain base-level compliance. To be successful, we request each user perform the following steps for both personal and organizational Outlook Mailboxes immediately. Please check your mailbox sizes.

1. Open Outlook.
2. Right click on your mailbox title bar, it should be shown as "Mailbox - Last, First..."
3. Click Properties for "Mailbox - Last, First..."
4. Click Folder Size
5. A window will open displaying your overall mailbox size as well as list the size of the subfolders within your mailbox.

By examining your subfolders you can determine where you need to clean up you mailbox. Remember that your Deleted Items and Sent Items folders count toward your mailbox total and those should be the first to be cleaned up.

AFI 91-207 USAFE Sup:  
3.5.2.1. (Added) In cases where separation of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic is not

feasible, military personnel in uniform must wear reflective accessories during periods of reduced visibility (hours of darkness, inclement weather, etc). Personnel in civilian attire are encouraged to wear light-colored clothing or reflective accessories. This requirement must be briefed during newcomers' orientation and addressed in the installation traffic code.

The Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) is hosting the Lajes Indoor Golf Challenge in celebration of Engineer Week. The event is co-sponsored by FSS and will be held in the TORC Ballroom on Friday, 4 March. Basically, the event is split into two phases...

1. Lajes currently has no indoor mini-golf course, so participants must construct a hole. Holes can be no larger than 4x16 feet. They can have battery operated movements, sounds and lights, but cannot tap into the ballroom outlets. Water hazards can also be used as a feature, but the water must remain contained within the hole itself (cannot spill). The mini-golf course will be available for public play throughout the weekend of 4-6 March...again there's no entrance fee or cost.
