MILITARY SPOUSE FINANCIAL COUNSELOR FELLOWSHIP

The Association of Financial Counseling and Planning Education - AFCPE - is working with the National Military Family Association and the FINRA Investor Education Foundation to provide up to 200 military spouses each year with funding to pay for the education they need to enter the financial counseling career field.

REFLECTIVE BELT ROE REMINDER:

AFI 91-207 USAFE Sup:
3.5.2.1. (Added) In cases where separation of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic is not feasible, military personnel in uniform must wear reflective accessories during periods of reduced visibility (hours of darkness, inclement weather, etc). Personnel in civilian attire are encouraged to wear light-colored clothing or reflective accessories. This requirement must be briefed during newcomers' orientation and addressed in the installation traffic code.


