TRICARE Online, www.tricareonline.com, is a DoD website that allows beneficiaries to make medical appointments online, keep a personal healthcare journal, get reliable medical information, and access TRICARE information about benefits and services.

TRICARE Prime and Plus beneficiaries in the serviced areas are currently able to use the site to make appointments with primary health care providers. The Web site features a 30- to 40-day calendar showing patients all available appointments with their primary care manager or the manager's team members where they're enrolled. Beneficiaries must set up a password-protected personal account on the site to take full advantage of TRICARE Online's power. TRICARE Online also has more than 18 million

pages of health and wellness information and disease management tools for military beneficiaries where they can record all their own health information in a secure medical journal.

REFLECTIVE BELT ROE REMINDER:

AFI 91-207 USAFE Sup:
3.5.2.1. (Added) In cases where separation of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic is not feasible, military personnel in uniform must wear reflective accessories during periods of reduced visibility (hours of darkness, inclement weather, etc). Personnel in civilian attire are

encouraged to wear light-colored clothing or reflective accessories. This requirement must be briefed during newcomers' orientation and addressed in the installation traffic code.


