### TIP OF THE WEEK

Is your dog scratching up a storm, but there are no fleas in sight? This is the season for what is commonly called “the island funk” and it is a fungus! If you notice your dog sitting in the corner, scratching constantly, or chewing on his paws, he may have this infection. When you get a dog wet, if he has light colored fur, you may notice he has large reddish splotches. While this is an infestation that does require veterinary care in order to get the medicine to wipe it out completely, you may get some relief for your dog by giving him bi-weekly or weekly baths with Dial antibacterial soap.
