

### PET TIP OF THE WEEK

Dental Care for Pets: What You Need to Know:

Many pet owners think that bad breath is normal for dogs and cats. It's not. The source of bad breath is often some form of dental disease. A whopping 80% of pets over the age of three suffer from dental problems. Baby teeth fall out after 6 months of age and after that point, the adult teeth require regular care and brushing in order to stay healthy. Most vets recommend brushing daily if possible, but generally the more wet food you feed them, the more you will need to brush. Hard food and bones/rawhides act as a sort of natural way to keep teeth healthier, but brushing is still needed every so often. Signs of dental

disease include tartar build up on the teeth, especially in the back, excessive drooling, inflamed gums, and missing/broken teeth and if left untreated, the infection can spread in the bloodstream to affect other organs. If you lack the time or knowledge to brush your pets' teeth, the kennel offers teeth brushing services starting at \$7.00. We or the vet clinic will also be happy to show you how to brush your pet's teeth at home.
