

TIP—KITTEN SEASON

The summer is here, and that means one thing...it's kitten season on Terceira. Feral mother cats on Terceira typically kick their babies out of the nest starting at 5

weeks. This is extremely early by normal standards, but that is how it is here. It is not uncommon to come across an abandoned litter of 5-8 mewling tiny kittens on this island.

If you find kittens, what should you do? You have several choices: First, you could leave them alone. This is probably the best solution. There are too many kittens on the island to take them to the shelter- you will more than likely be turned away. It sounds harsh, but cats have been surviving and procreating on this island for many years. True, some may starve or be killed, but the vast majority of them will survive.

Unfortunately, the Atlantic Island Kennel does not have the space or ability to accept strays. Second, you could take it home, get it checked out by the vet clinic, and either keep it or foster it until you are able to re-home it. If you choose this option, please make sure you are not violating the terms of your housing agreement and/or lease. Kittens younger than 3 weeks are a huge responsibility and need a diligent feeding schedule to survive. If you are unsure what to do, please feel free to call the kennel staff or the vet clinic for advice.
