TIP—ADOPTING A PET

So you want to adopt a new furry family member? Great! There are many cats and dogs on this island who would love to go home with you. But, a word of caution. Please make sure to do your research on dog breeds and the care your new cat or dog will need. They have a lifespan of anywhere from 7-20+ years and you should never adopt an animal with the intention of re-homing it. Pets are by nature, a human's best friend...and it damages them somewhat to be passed from home to home.

Puppies and kittens require more initial time and money in terms of housebreaking, booster shots, spay/neuter and socialization with other people and animals. Adult cats and dogs still need annual veterinary visits and may need to be fixed as well.

Please keep in mind it can be expensive to PCS with an animal. Please do your research and plan accordingly.

Terceira and especially Lajes Field has a very high rate of animals being re-homed and it is heartbreaking for the animals and their owners. If you want to adopt a pet, please call the kennel. We know several foster homes on the island as well as the locations of the animal shelters and would love to help you find your perfect addition.
