



CHANGE IN TUITION ASSISTANCE MANAGEMENT

On 12 July Central Office at Randolph assumed responsibility for financial management of Tuition Assistance in USAFE. By the end of summer all TA financial matters at all locations in the Air Force will be handled by this Central Office.

The effects of this change are:

- 1) Payment of school TA invoices will be processed by CO not by each local base
- 2) Grades will be updated in the AFAEMS database by CO
- 3) Reimbursements for non-passing grades ("I", "F", "D" at graduate level, Withdrawals, and waiver requests) will be managed by CO. This affects the manner in which members repay the cost of TA to the AF.

Members are urged to speak to Education Services about any TA concerns.
