

CHANGE IN TUITION ASSISTANCE MANAGEMENT

On 12 July Central Office at Randolph assumed responsibility for financial management of Tuition Assistance in USAFE. By the end of summer all TA

financial matters at all locations in the Air Force will be handled by this Central Office.

The effects of this change are:

- 1) Payment of school TA invoices will be processed by CO not by each local base
- 2) Grades will be updated in the AFAEMS database by CO
- 3) Reimbursements for non-passing grades ("I", "F", "D" at graduate level, Withdrawals, and waiver requests) will be managed by CO. This affects the manner in which members repay the cost of TA to the AF. Members are urged to speak to Education Services about any TA concerns.

TIPS FROM THE KENNEL STAFF

It is PCS season and many of us are leaving the island... Are you ready? Is your pet? The requirements to take a pet out of Lajes are usually simple, especially if you are returning stateside. Generally, up to date rabies and a health certificate signed by an off base veterinarian are enough to get your pet home. You can contact the vet clinic on base to find out more.

Definitely check out whatever state you will be living in and their pet requirements, as sometimes these can differ slightly. If you are travelling to another overseas assignment, it is vital to check out that country's requirements. Some like the UK and Guam are very specific and it is not possible to bring a pet if you wait

until last minute. As soon as you have your assignment, start doing your research and don't wait!

Here, you can find everything from reviews on pet carriers to updates on different commercial airline's flight requirements to articles about pet friendly places.

The AMC pet requirements are listed on lajesfss.com under Newcomer Info and Shipment. That part of the information is the same whether you are coming or going.
