



TIP OF THE WEEK

Today we are going to talk about anal glands...wait what? Yes, you read that correctly. Also called scent glands, anal glands are two small sacs located at 8 o'clock and 4 o'clock from your dog's rectum.

Have you ever noticed how dogs when meeting each other will sniff each other's bottoms? Have you noticed how maybe your dog is far too fascinated with the scent of another dog's poop in the grass? Well, the anal glands are the explanation.

Designed to release a small bit of fluid anytime the rectum is contracted (like when your dog is taking a poop or is excited by meeting another dog), the fluid is charged with a scent that belongs ONLY to your dog and tells all the other dogs around who he is. Usually, the anal glands are emptied on their own naturally, but especially for small breeds, this is not always the case.

A professional such as a veterinarian or a groomer can usually take care of the problem by "expressing" the anal glands. This is a delicate procedure as you can imagine! It is possible to do them yourself, but if you are not sure

what you are doing, you can cause injury, especially if there is a problem.

Veterinarians recommend having the glands, especially of small breeds, checked once a month. Some dogs only need them expressed every few months while others need it done once a month. Our new groomer has the knowledge and expertise to express anal glands. If you need a grooming appointment, please contact the kennel at 535-3855.
