





DO YOU KNOW OUR CONTINUOUS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS?

The schools' second goal is, "All students, by 2014, will increase their proficiency in math through improvement in number relationships and application across the curriculum as measured by system-wide and school based assessments."

Take your cameras on a scavenger hunt and take pictures of real-world examples of geometry. For example, a traffic pylon could represent a "cone," a tall building a "prism," or a railroad tracks "parallel lines." After the hunt is over explain how these pictures reflect the geometry term.


