**Continuous School Improvement (CSI) Tidbits**

Goal 1: All students, by 2014, will increase their proficiency in critical reading through improvement in analyzing text in all content areas as measured by system-wide and school based assessments.

- While traveling in the car make a list of all the nouns that you see. Organize them into a theme for a story. This can be done with verbs- write down all the action that passes you while you are in the car.

Goal 2: All students, by 2014, will increase their proficiency in math through improvement in number relationships and application across the curriculum as measured by system-wide and school based assessments.

- Search for all the parallel, perpendicular, and intersecting lines in the cracks of sidewalks, parking lots, walls outside and inside your home. Take it one step further and look for right angles, acute and obtuse angles.
