

UPDATE: CHANGE TO THE REQUIREMENT FOR COMPLETION OF COURSE 14 V.5 OR 14 V.6 IS MANDATORY FOR STUDENTS TO ATTEND THE FUTURE RESIDENT SNCO ALE SCHEDULED TO LAUNCH IN JUNE 14.

Course 14, Version 5 testing deadline has been extended to 30 Nov 13 for members currently enrolled. After 30 Nov 13, members will not be permitted to take any further exams and will not be given partial credit for incomplete course work. In other words, you must complete the entire course to receive credit. Second, Course 14 Version 6 enrollment will be open on 1 Oct 13 and members will have one year to complete from date of enrollment. Within the construct of EPME Transformation, Version 6 was designed as a foundation DL course for those selected to attend the ALE resident course which is scheduled for launch in June 2014. The policy requiring ONLY Version 6 to establish eligibility for ALE is currently under review.




SOFT CLAWS


