

CONTINUOUS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT TIDBITS

Goal 1: All students, by 2014, will increase their proficiency in critical reading through improvement in analyzing text in all content areas as measured by system-wide and school based assessments.

- Ask your child to MAKE INFERENCES OR DRAW CONCLUSIONS or MAKE PREDICTIONS from subtle statements or certain circumstances. Simple situations your

child can respond to could be a wilted flower, a car in the ditch, "The BX is closed today", the floor is wet, the shopping cart is left by the stairs, the tree is bare, the stoned wall is missing stones, etc.

Goal 2: All students, by 2014, will increase their proficiency in math through improvement in number relationships and application across the curriculum as measured by system-wide and school based assessments.

- Pick three objects in the house that measure less than a foot. Measure them in inches and then in centimeters.

In addition, you can help the school by sending a response email, telling us how you are working on the above strategies at home or photos to help us document evidence of your child working on the goals at home!

How to enter:

Participants provide a one-page essay of 500 words or less (excluding title): *“Who or What Inspires You to Be Successful?” Why?*

This requirement must be submitted on a CD. In addition to the title, the essay page must have the participant’s name, date and word count. Essays must have a one-inch top and bottom margin, a 1.25 inch left and right margin, single-spaced and double spaced between paragraphs. Essay must be typed in MSWord 12-point, Times New Roman font.

You must complete the entry form and provide current college/university acceptance letter for new students or official transcripts for those already enrolled.

All essay packages must be submitted to the Force Support Squadron, Marketing Department, T-112, room 205 or 207 by Monday, 1 July 2013. **DO NOT** mail directly to the installation or AFPC/SVOF; entries mailed directly from applicant to AFPC/SVOF will be discarded.

Scholarship requirements are strictly enforced! Not meeting these requirements will result in disqualification!

Eligibility

Current Air Force club member or dependent family member (spouse, son, daughter, stepson and stepdaughter) who has been accepted by or enrolled in an accredited college or university for entry during the fall term as a part-time or full-time student.
